We would like to alert the school community regarding the above proposed development of 26 apartments, 9 retail units and 120 plus car parking spaces adjacent to and overlooking the school yard and buildings.

Following the planning application in November 2009 by Moriarty Foodmarkets Ltd. Fingal County Council's planning office requested additional information from the Applicant. This information must be provided to Fingal by no later than **14th July 2010**.

This proposed development is substantial and will have significant impact on the school and town.

The **two weeks** following the submission (again, we anticipate the revised submission will be sent to Fingal on or before 14 July 2010) is the period within which it is absolutely vital that your observations are lodged. Any later is too late. All relevant information for the proposed development is available on www.fingalcoco.ie/planning. The reference number is **FO9A/0580**.

Those people who successfully lodged observations in Nov 09 may do so again – it is open to Fingal to **accept or reject** letters / observations from other people who failed to lodge an objection. It is free of charge.

As school closes today we cannot circulate further information to you - therefore it is imperative that each concerned individual keeps themselves informed and prepares observations and delivers them promptly to Fingal County Council.
